



## CONDITIONS OF PLAY PINK BALL COMPETITION



***This Pink Ball competition is going to be played in teams of 4, where each person takes a turn to play with the pink ball instead of their own ball and their score on that hole is recorded on the Pink Ball Card as well as their own score card.***

1. Team to consist of 4 players. Each player to play their own individual Stableford game.
2. Nominate a Captain to score the Pink Team Card
3. **Example of Pink Ball use**
  - a. Player 1 uses the pink ball on the 1<sup>st</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup> & 13<sup>th</sup> holes
  - b. Player 2 uses the pink ball on the 2<sup>nd</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> holes
  - c. Player 3 uses the pink ball on the 3<sup>rd</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> holes
  - d. Player 4 uses the pink ball on the 4<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> holes
  - e. Nominate 2 players to play one extra hole each with the pink ball for the last 2 holes.
4. Each player would use the Pink ball 4 times (i.e. every fourth hole) and 2 players would use the Pink ball 5 times.
5. Note: When the player is using the pink ball they do not use their own ball on that hole but they do score on their own individual card as well.
6. If the Pink ball is lost, nominate another ball as the pink ball and continue.
