



# Policy – Dress Regulations

Constitution Clause: N/A

The Grange Golf Club requires a respectable standard of dress consistent with a prestigious private golf club

## **COURSE & PRACTICE FACILITIES**

Whether playing or practicing all members and their guests must be attired in clothing designed for golf (NOT casual wear adapted for golf)

Male players must wear a collared shirt TUCKED in at all times

Sport socks to be predominantly white. Sockettes/ankle socks to be white or matching the predominant colour of the golfers outfit

EXCLUDED: Members AND their guests may NOT at any time wear:

- Metal spiked golf shoes
- Cargo shorts / trousers, jeans, tracksuits, or other casual wear not designed for golf
- Motifs larger than pocket size
- Gym attire
- Business socks

## **CLUBHOUSE**

We recognise members and their guests wish to enjoy our hospitality facilities in a more relaxed manner and therefore patrons are requested to dress accordingly

We ask that members and their guests dress in smart casual attire

Dress sandals and Boat Shoes are permitted for Male members

EXCLUDED: Members and their guests may NOT at any time wear:

- Thongs, scuffs or crocs
- Tracksuits
- Shorts or trousers with an elastic waistband (males only)
- Hats of any description
- Ripped, frayed or torn jeans (including designer)
- Singlets
- Gym attire



The Grange reserves the right to refuse admission to any person, who in the opinion of an employee or agent of the Club, is deemed to be inappropriately attired.
